

## STEP 1

Open your package and check to make sure you have received:

- 1- Heshen Bag
- 2- 2 poles with hooks
- 3- Collapsible Frame
- 4- Bonus set of eyelets
- 5- 4 Screw tops for eyelet anchor points
- 6- Printed media with 4 eyelets in corners



## STEP 2

Take the X-frame stand-up kit and expand it into an upright position on a flat ground surface



## STEP 3

Grab the two top poles and lock them into place on the top of the base as shown in the image below



## STEP 4

Open the small back of parts and take out the screw end caps that will fit directly over the top of the top and bottom poles to safely secure the media in place.



## STEP 5

Place the media with corner positioned eyelets over the screw bits at each of the corner poles attached to the X-frame. You may need to pull the media a little in order to create some tension on the media in order for the x-frame to stand tight.



## STEP 6

Your X-Frame is ready to position where-ever you need to place it. Voila! Your new X-frame is expanded and looking great.



## Additional Care & Instructions

- 1- When opening your banner for the first time, take care and attention but also take your time. Slowly take all the accessories out of the bag and check that you have all the parts.
- 2- When putting up, ensure that the printed media is fixed neatly on the X-frame correctly and carefully.
- 3- Do not attached anything to the media that is not meant to be on there (i.e. No tape, media, velcro, etc...) Adding other adhesive may damage the surface of the media and the printing too.
- 4- When packing your X-frame back inside the bag, ensure that you roll the media up with the print on the inside to avoid any damage to the print whilst in the bag.
- 5- Do not wipe the media with any chemicals as this may also damage the surface and the print. You can however use a soft cloth, slightly damp with water to wipe any dirt or dust.
- 6- MIS-handling and failure to follow the instructions will result in handling damage which will not be covered under our warranty.
